

Your obligations

As an applicant for NSW State Nomination through RDA Orana for my Skilled Nominated (subclass 489) Visa you must ensure that the information contained in your application is true and correct.

It is an offence for a person to make a false or misleading statement when applying for the visa and if it is determined that an applicant has provided incorrect or misleading information to obtain a visa, then prosecution may be commenced.

Privacy statement

The information you provide with your application is collected by Regional Development Australia - Orana (RDA Orana) and will be used to assess your application for NSW State nomination through RDA Orana for a Skilled Nominated (Subclass 489) Visa. You consent to RDA Orana using the information to process your application. This information may be provided to third parties with your consent or as required or permitted by law. Information may be used according to the RDA Orana general Privacy Policy and the specific Migration Privacy Statement.

- The information contained in my application for NSW State Nomination through RDA Orana for my Skilled Nominated (subclass 489) Visa is true, correct and accurate.
 - I will live and work in the Orana region for at least two years following my visa grant / permanent arrival.
 - My spouse / partner relationship (*if applicable*) is genuine and will meet the Home Affairs' requirements relating to spouse / partner relationships.
 - I understand that RDA Orana will monitor my settlement in the Orana region for two years from date of permanent arrival and I agree to comply with the ongoing monitoring program.
 - I undertake to notify Home Affairs of any material change to my circumstances associated with my living arrangements and/or the status of my relationship in writing within a period of 14 days from the date of the change.
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- I understand that RDA Orana may inform Home Affairs if I do not make a genuine effort to meet my obligation to live in the Orana region for at least two years from the date of visa grant / permanent arrival.
- I am aware that Australian labour market conditions may vary significantly as the employment market fluctuates at different times of the year; and from year to year.
- I understand that no representation or warranty is made to me by RDA Orana regarding securing employment on the Orana region and I need to be realistic about employment expectations as it can take some time to secure skilled employment.
- I understand that I will compete for employment vacancies with all people in the labour market as part of a normal selection process.
- I understand that RDA Orana is not responsible for finding employment, accommodation or providing a financial incentive to Orana region nominated skilled migrants and I release RDA Orana from any claims arising from the visa application made by me, or any subsequent employment.
- Where an applicant subscribes to our Settlement Assistance Package, RDA Orana will endeavour to provide up to date advice and assistance, however the ultimate responsibility for finding suitable employment and necessary services will rest with the applicant.
- I understand that the RDA Orana or its' employees are not liable for any inaccuracies or omissions in the information provided to the applicant in the context of their application for subclass 489 nomination.
