## REGIONS WITH LESS LIKELIHOOD OF SUCESSS IN NOMINATION GRANTS

Below are the regions with less likelihood of success in nomination grants and we do not encourage applicants to approach below regions unless the applicant possesses unique circumstances as mentioned below

**Victoria** – To assure a positive nomination grant, Victoria requires a confirm job offer from a Victorian employer for your nominated occupation or in a closely related occupation or concessional arrangements are available for international graduates who have studied in their institutions.

**Northern Territory (Darwin)** – This region will not accommodate IT professionals without a confirmed job offer letter from a NT Employer for a closely related occupation and all other applicants too should provide evidence of having strong employment ties with possible NT employers to assure a positive nomination grant.

**Western Australia**- Western Australia has the most strict selection criteria for off-shore applicants with limited number of occupations in their SMP and having a confirm job offer is mandatory for the nomination grant for off-shore applicants . A concessional arrangement is available for international graduates in WA.

**NSW-Sydney** – This region offers nominations for 190 Direct PR avenue and applicants with Higher points grading (\* 70/75/80 marks from the immigration point test) can have some hopes about the process.

**NSW-Murry Region** – With our Past experience, we have identified the nomination processing pattern of this region and they mostly tend to refuse Off-shore applicants with general profiles. They tend to accept applicants who have studied or worked in Murry region they only have the highest likelihood of success in receiving a positive nomination grant.

**NSW-Northern Rivers** –This NSW regional city will only accommodate onshore applicants who are currently employed in their region

**NSW-Central West**- This region has a habit of refusing most of the Off-Shore nomination applications and tend to accept on-shore applicants with Australian work experience or Australian Education or preferably applicants who are currently residing in Central West .
