

Some crucial advice by CDC on Australian migration application

All hopeful applicants are advised to take serious note of the following key points in order to lodge a successful EOI.

We suggest that applicants must focus on finalising their EOIs targeting the preferred region (s) and finalization of the required documents for the state nomination process as swiftly as possible. You may consult us about the lead documents that are required for the next stages and we have fixed the final date to receive finalized documents as 10th of November 2019 in order to prepare applicants for the 16th November competitive application process. If it is not possible to submit an application by this date, your next intake would be on 1st of July 2020. Therefore start planning your documents and finances as soon as possible to ensure no shortage of funds or lapse of documents when the time arrives to lodge.

Immigration's Skill Select and State Nomination quotas might reset on 16th November, opening up places in the Subclass 189, 190, and 491 (State or family Nominated) visa streams. Obtaining an invitation for the 189 visa would be more competitive than ever, so potential applicants should look to lodge an Expression of Interest as soon as possible.

States will also review their occupation lists on 16th November and some may only remain open for a short period of time, therefore it is to your advantage to be organised and ready to submit an EOI for a 190 or 491 visas in time. This means gathering the required documents; skill assessments, qualifications, identity documents, and employment references. Don't leave sitting for the English test until the last minute, as there may be a delay for an examination appointment due to increasing the number of potential applicants for this intake.

Strategically getting ahead with the application lodgement race

As experienced in previous years, this November too we expect an extensive application lodgement traffic and a competitive situation that will be impractical to cope with by the CDC support service staff. Last time CDC experienced certain number of unexpected failures as some occupational ceilings were met within 30 minutes to one hour time frame. As a result we failed to lodge some of the applications in time as we had massive number of applications to process using the service of CDC staff along with an outsourced service team. To avoid such inconveniences for both parties, this time we have decided to execute a collaborative effort with our applicants to face this challenge effectively. In view of this situation we decided to encourage applicants to lodge their nomination applications independently while the EOI lodgements will be done by CDC.

A Few Important Tips To Enhance Speediness of Data Entry.

We kindly advise all hopeful applicants to make note of the following in order to ensure a speedier data process can take place which will benefit everyone.

- Collect your EOI preview from us and make sure to import the same sequence of information and claims to your nomination application.
- Since you are doing it independently there is no need for an Agent ID.
- Refer the sample application given by the relevant support service staff member and get ready with pre-typed appropriately answered FAQs in a Word.doc format as you will hardly get time to type things once the application acceptance starts.

- Do not indicate that you have further study plans after you migrate. It will definitely be a ground for a rejection of your nomination application. Always focus on your employment potentials in your preferred region.
- Inaccurately typed details that contradict with your EOI claims also will lead for a refusal and the application should be 100% accurately compiled with appropriate supportive documents. The typing errors and wrong submissions cannot be rectified with the authorities after submitting the documents.
- If they ask for original scanned documents, you must obey the instruction and photocopies should not be produced for the process. If they ask for certified copies, each and every page of the supportive documents should be certified by a lawyer as a 'True Copy' of the originals. Make sure that the seal and the lawyer's certification are blue in color and avoid black color.
- Accuracy of the typed data in the application forms should be verified with the assigned officer prior to the lodgment
- The settlement funds requirement vary according to the number of family members and kindly discuss the correct amount that should be stated in your application with your officer and some regions will not ask for settlement funds evidence.
- You have to use your own words when you give explanations in the application forms and do not use the same sample answers that are given in the sample application form. It will be a cause for a refusal
- If you encounter any difficulties on the day of launching your application, immediately contact the assigned support service officer and get the necessary advices. Mobile number- Mr. Anuja- 0777150589 or our office general numbers.
- Your completed application will be automatically saved in the online system and make sure to send us a copy of your work for pre lodgment data verification process. Any errors made while entering data to your application can be corrected by the CDC staff.
- Very important: application processing fees will be varied according to the region and you have to have a readily available credit card to make this payment online. It is strongly urged that all hopeful applicants pay serious attention to this issue in case the card gets declined at the point of the lodgment of the application, which will result in all your efforts being wasted.
