- **Reply to this email**, confirming that you wish to be considered for NT Government nomination and that you agree to the commitments stipulated in the declaration below. ***Please ensure that you have typed your full name at the bottom of the declaration. Please ensure that you do not delete any part of this email when replying.***

Please note the following important information:

- The commitments made in the declaration are conditions of your nomination.
- Nominations are ultimately dependent on your continued eligibility for the subclass 491 visa and available quota. If your nomination is successful, you will be sent an email from SkillSelect with an invitation to apply for a subclass 491 visa.
- MigrationNT is only able to consider you for a subclass 491 nomination, and we are not in a position to consider requests for a subclass 190 nomination at this stage.
- MigrationNT is not in a position to provide updates as to the status of nomination. If we are unable to nominate you within this program year (ending 30 June 2023), we will consider you for nomination in the new program year (commencing 1 July 2023). However, this will be dependent on available quota.

Please note that if we do not receive your response by **Friday 27 May 2023**, we may not be able to issue a nomination.
